Bhubaneswar, Oct 6: Chief Minister Naveen Patnaik Thursday inaugurated 100 urban piped drinking water supply projects. With the objective of provide safe drinking water to every house in Orissa, he also laid the foundation stone for another 100 projects though a video conference at the state secretariat here.

Two systems - Online Smart Water Information Management (OSWIM) and e-Building Pass – were also launched at the function. While OSWIM will ensure safety of drinking water being supplied, the second system will smoothen the permission process for construction of buildings.

"The state government is working with a commitment towards improving urban governance in the state. While 100 urban drinking water projects were dedicated today, work on another 100 has started," officials said.

810 ASOs receive appointment letter
