

# RMC in talks with Common Services Centres

**Rourkela, Jan 27:** The ADM-cum Administrator and Commissioner, Rourkela Municipal Corporation, held talks with the proprietors of Common Service Centres (CSCs) operating in Rourkela Friday. With a view to enhancing access to urban services to citizens, RMC called a meeting to evaluate the option of providing these services including Birth and Death certificates, Marriage certificates, Trade License certificate, Payment of Property Tax and Water Tax through the CSCs operating across the city.

Representatives from nine CSCs operating in various locations (Panposh, Chhend, Basanti Colony, Udit Nagar etc.) across the city attended the meeting and expressed their willingness for providing the services to the citizens. Once the CSCs start to roll out such services, citizens would be able to avail these services from locations in their proximity and will significantly save time and travel expenses.

"We are in talks with the Odisha E-Governance Services Ltd. (OeSL), which is a SPV of Odisha Computer Application Centre (OCAC), Govt. of Odisha & IL&FS, for rolling out the services to citizens through the CSCs at the earliest," Commissioner, RMC said.
